## Leon County Supervisor of Elections Releases Sample Ballots for 2024 Primary Election

**Leon County, FL** – Mark S. Earley, Supervisor of Elections for Leon County, releases sample ballots for the 2024 Primary Election. "Starting today, Leon County voters can view their Primary Election sample ballot online," said Supervisor Earley. "Sample ballots are an important resource for voters, as it shows the races and candidates that will appear on your specific ballot. By reading your sample ballot before voting, you have time to think carefully about your choices. I encourage every voter to view their sample ballot so they will be Election Ready for the August 20 Primary Election."

Voters can view the specific sample ballot for their precinct and party by visiting <u>LeonVotes.gov</u> and clicking on the "Your Voter Info" button. In addition to these specific sample ballots, generic sample ballots that list all the races in Leon County will be mailed to every voter at the end of July.

The deadline to register to vote for the August 20 Primary Election is July 22. This is also the deadline to change party affiliation in time for the Primary Election. "If you are not yet registered to vote, now is the time to do so," said Supervisor Earley. "Some races will be decided entirely during the Primary Election, so voters who do not vote in the Primary will miss their chance to vote in these important local contests."

Voters may register or change their political party using any of these methods:

- Online at <u>RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov</u>.
- Mail a voter registration form to PO Box 7357, Tallahassee, FL 32314-7357.
- Visit the Leon County Supervisor of Elections Office at 2990-1 Apalachee Parkway.
